

2006 HEADWATERS AREA FOOD BANK ANNUAL REPORT

FOOD BANK SERVICES

The Headwaters Area Food Bank provides emergency food services to families residing in Three Forks, Manhattan, Willow Creek, Harrison, Pony, and the surrounding area. Food requests are honored twice monthly. Services consist of a three day nutritionally balanced supply of food.

2006 Summary:

- The Food Bank provided foods to 105 households (261 individuals) representing 568 total requests for emergency food assistance throughout the year.
- The ages of individuals served were: 38.7% under the age of 18; 55.9% between the ages of 18-59; 5.4% ages 60 and over
- Places of residency for households served were: 73% Three Forks; 9.5% Manhattan/Logan; 6.7% Willow Creek; 10.8% outlying areas
- The #1 reported reason for requesting emergency food assistance was the cost of housing
- Of the households requesting assistance, 39.36% reported the head of household as employed
- 49.51% of households requesting assistance, did so three times or less within the 2006 calendar year
- The types of households served are represented by the following percentages: 13% Single Parent; 26% Adults Only; 17% Single Adult; 11% Mixed Adults with Children; 18% Two Parent; 15% Seniors

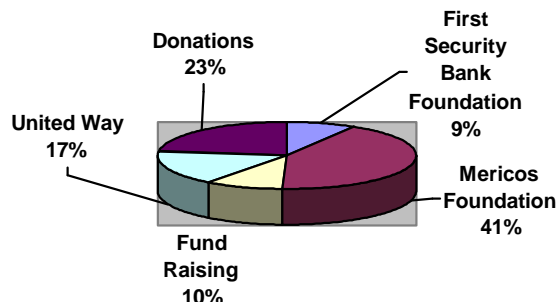

July 2005 - June 2006 Funding Sources



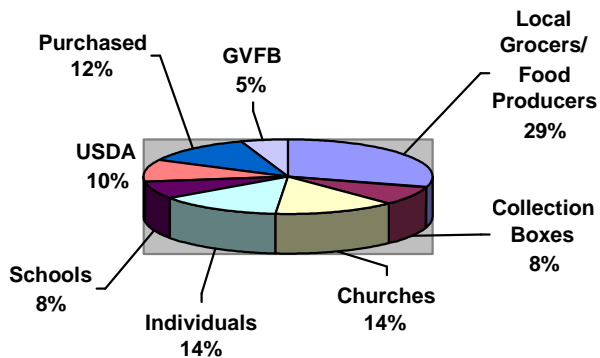
