During the month of May the Food Bank provided 1,051 Boxes of
Emergency Food Assistance to 1,033 households consisting of 2,187 individuals.
This equates to serving 51.6 households per day in Bozeman and 4.5 households per Saturday in Belgrade.
125 new households were served during the month accounting for 12.1% of all households served.
